Only God Can Make a Tree

The consideration one of the details of nature, for instance, the tree, is impressive. Can anyone believe that a tree, which serves as shade and food for men and animals, as food and shelter for the birds, and is ornamentation to the landscape, can anyone believe that the tree just happened, that no one planted it and designed it to serve all these useful purposes? The normal human mind cannot believe that the tree “just happened,” but agrees with the poet, who said:

*“Poems are made by fools like me,
But only God can make a tree.”*

Only God can make a tree! Only God would have thought of it, just as only God would have thought of the apple blossoms to proceed the apples. How thoughtful He is, taking endless trouble about things no one else would think mattered, – having all the colors ready for the flowers each Spring, and teaching each bird its proper song!

No wonder that Lord Kelvin affirms that the evidences in nature for the existence of a Greater are overwhelming, that the proof in nature for design and intelligence, is overpowering. Another scientist says, “The universe appears to have been designed by a great mathematician; the universe looks less like a great machine than it does like a great thought.” This is one way of saying that the universe and all its parts, great and small, shows an infinitely thoughtful plan, a deliberate design, and only an intelligent being can think, and fashion, and plan. Therefore, from the evident design of the universe, we must conclude with the very first question in the little catechism, “Who made the world? God made the world. Who is God? God is the Creator of Heaven and earth and of all things.”

What wisdom does the Church of God not manifest in thus impressing upon the child's mind in its first youth that most fundamental of truths: God is the Creator of Heaven and Earth and of all things. Consider the little child at her mother's side learning for the first time that God made the sun and stars that shine down on her and that one day she will render an account to Him, her merciful Lord. That child is a wiser scholar, a more

profound philosopher, than any university professor who does not know that beyond space is the Spaceless, the infinite Lord and Master of the universe. What wisdom, then, is manifested by the Catholic Church of God in keeping this truth before our minds from our earliest youth until the end.
