Some say: "Does not Evolution explain the universe?"; To which we answer: "Neither evolution nor any other theory throws the slightest ray of light on the **beginnings** of things. Push the world back as far as you like; say that all things, the sun, the moon and stars, and everything, began with a vaporous gas or a gaseous molecule which, by the process of evolution, gradually involved and expanded into our present universe, – we still want to know who made that gaseous molecule, who made that first term of life, who made that primeval cell. "From nothing, nothing can come forth."

Again, what is the answer to the objection that the idea of God arose from a primitive fear which was aroused by witnessing the marvels of nature? The answer is that the storm, a tidal wave, certainly aroused fear in primitive man, as they do now, but how could that make primitive men fear God, if primitive men did not know God? God must be known before we can fear Him. To arrive at a knowledge of God, primitive man need not look at the storm alone. He could look at the stars, which would speak to him of God as eloquently as the storm. The existence of God, the study of religions shows, is the primary conclusion of human reason, that is to say, history teaches us that in all tribes, before there were idols or a multiplicity of gods, there was first a belief in one supreme Being. Only later in their history, because of sin and superstition, did the idols and the multiplicity of gods appear.

"But was not God invented by man?" There is no record in history of such an invention. The last thing man would do would be to invent God, a Being Who imposes an urgent moral law and strict responsibility to Himself. It is sometimes said that God was invented by priests, but here the objector puts the cart before the

horse, because the priests in all religions is a mediator between God and man and, therefore, before there could be a priest, there would have to be a belief in God; the priest cannot be accused of inventing what preceded him.
